

MCHS Band Boosters

Meeting Minutes
Monday, May 5, 2008

The regular meeting of the MCHS Band Boosters was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on 5/5/2008 in the MCHS Band Room by President Daneane Jones.

Present

Approval of Minutes

- The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved as read.

Financial Report

- Kathi Hopkins reported that we have \$5473.71 in checking and \$1,871.28 in savings. In the past month, we have paid for the Kokopelli bike (\$370), Lanmark for seat cushions (\$457.35), and Pioneer Printing for the raffle tickets (\$168)

Submission of Bills

Rodney submitted the following bill/payment requests:

- Awards/Engraving for senior awards
- Jazz Band Hotel Rooms for GJ Trip – kids were charged \$20 per person, collected \$400 total. Total for hotel rooms was \$623, Rodney would like us to reimburse the 740 account with a check to MCHS for \$223.
- Senior Composite Picture – around \$250-300
- Purchase of awards – school should cover those
- GJ Transportation for Fule - \$1201.20 for Colorado West trip, \$876.57 for CBA Festival. A total of \$2,077.77 goes to MCHS as a standalone payment/check.
- Reimburse the Ashton's for Britney's performance at state – costs. \$100
- A motion was made to approve all current and pending expenditures. The motion was passed.

Rodney's Report

- CBA Festival – Rodney reported that the band received 1 “2” and 2 “3”s
- Colorado West Festival – kids played well and received straight 2's
- Group size next year may end up between 90-100 students.
- DC Trip – Several students have not paid in full nor will they be able to by trip time. Rodney is talking to contacts in the community to help these students.
- Marching Show (Jack Chambers) – the show is \$4,000, \$2,000 of which is due up front. The first payment is due around June and the second is due in October.
- Possibility of excess funds: During the budget meeting tonight, we found out that the activity fee is divided \$35 to the school and \$20 to the 740 account for the activity. There is the possibility of extra money in the 740 account for band that we did not know about. Rodney will check into that and ask for that money to be applied to the transportation costs from GJ so that we don't have to reimburse as much.

Old Business

- There was no old business to report on.

New Business

- Silent Auction – Cathy Mangan reported that it is going well and that setup will start around 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday 5/7.
- Spring Raffle – All tickets are due to Annette Jackson asap. Raffle is at 8:00 p.m in the gym during the band fest.
