Meeting Minutes
Monday, November 3, 2008

The regular meeting of the MCHS Band Boosters was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on 11/3/2008 in the MCHS Band Room by President Daneane Jones. The attendance from that meeting is attached to these minutes.

Approval of Minutes

- The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved as read.

Financial Report

- Kathi Hopkins reported that we have \$ 5,315.22 in checking and \$1,873.61 in savings.
- We received \$940.13 from the Community Appreciation Concert and \$656.01 from the Bake Sale held last weekend.
- A motion was made to pass the financial report; the motion was seconded and passed.

Submission of Bills

Rodney submitted the following bills for approval and payment:

- We received \$2,193 from raffle sales.

Rodney's Report

- Rodney reported that the final performance at State was a good performance

- Rodney reported that the band received the only Superior rating in Class 2 in Flagstaff this weekend. Only three other bands received this rating, and they were all in Class 1. They received Outstanding Music and Outstanding Guard awards.

New Business

- Daneane Jones suggested that we pay Tyia Klein \$600 for her help in finishing the guard program after it was left incomplete when the gentleman we usually use left the country. Tyia ended up doing over 50% of the program herself. This motion was made from the group, seconded, and passed.
- Linda Brewer presented information on the Tupperware fundraiser for November, which will close on Friday, 11/14.2008. Rocky will send information out via email and Rodney will send information home with the students.
- Becky O’Camb reported on upcoming fundraisers, including a Christmas Concert cookie exchange and auction, Ink Cartridge Recycling. Bake sales, and others. She will continue to hold fundraising committee meetings monthly and everyone is encouraged to attend
